

RE/MAX associates and business partners participated in a host of fundraising events such as the hockey tournament, live and silent auctions including Tiffany & Company jewelry, a custom stained glass masterpiece, sports memorabilia and vacation packages to name a few. In addition to the annual fundraiser, participating RE/MAX sales associates contribute a portion of their income throughout the year via the RE/MAX Miracle Home® Program, and host local fundraisers such as golf tournaments, head shaves and bowl-a-thons.
